About Hospice Care

Hospice is a philosophy of care allowing an entire team of care disciplines to come to the patient, whether in a private home or facility, when a patient, the family and physician have decided that curative care is no longer helpful or healing, and that end of life (EOL) could occur within six months.

There is no cost to the patient or the family for this service and all prescriptions and medical equipment associated with the prognosis is covered.

The Hospice Team does include: Our Physicians to support your own doctor, RN Case Manager, LVN, Home Health Aide, Medical Social Worker, All-faith Chaplain, Volunteers and Bereavement Coordinator to support the family.

Green Valley is a California licensed agency serving patient families in the Sacramento, Placer, El Dorado and Yolo region of our communities. Locally owned and managed, our office is in Roseville and our teams reside in various locations throughout our service area to insure rapid response time.

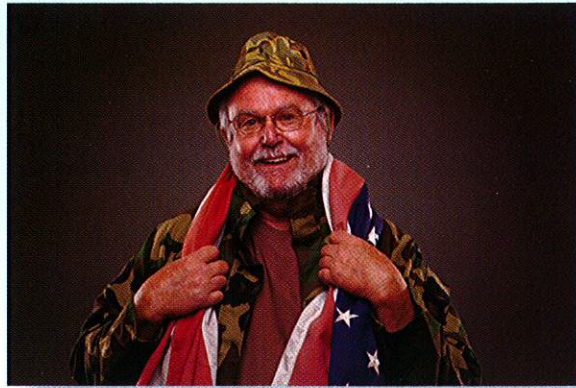

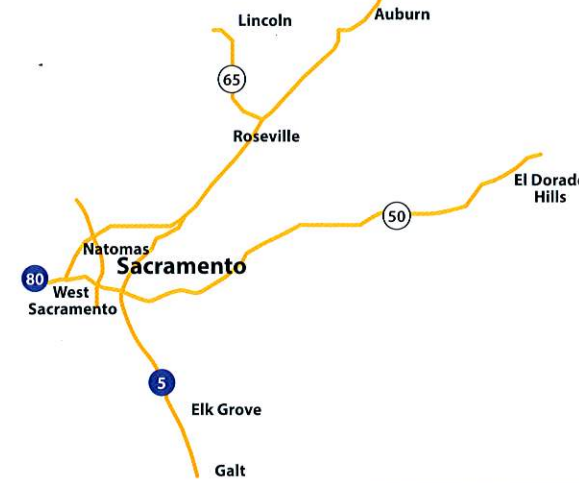
Green Valley Hospice is a recognized as a program participant by California Hospice and Palliative Care Organization.
